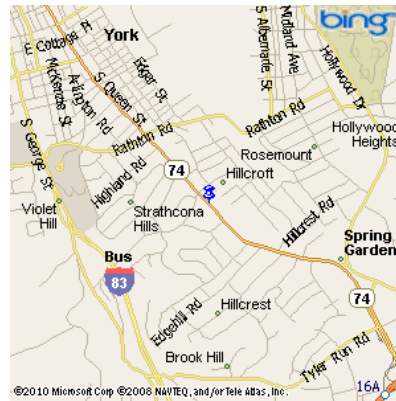

Driving Directions



If you have an emergency:

Call **717-767-5355** to inform the staff that you are enroute to the hospital.

If your pet has swallowed a foreign object or harmful substance, call the hospital before you induce vomiting.

If your pet has been exposed to a potentially toxic substance, bring any available packaging with you.

If your pet is bleeding, wrap the area with a bandage.

If your pet has been hit by a car, place them on a blanket to act as a stretcher and gently cover them for transport.

CAUTION: Injured animals may bite!

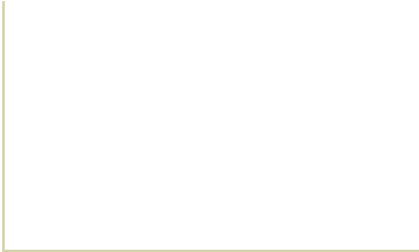
